Did you know?

The University of the Pacific (UOP) in Stockton, California offers degrees from eleven professional schools—the only private college with fewer than 10,000 students with this distinction.

Founded in 1851 in Santa Clara, Pacific is the oldest chartered university in California. Its original name, California Wesleyan College, reflected its affiliation with the Methodist Church which continued into the late 1960s.

Pacific was the inaugural independent, co-educational college in California, opening the first conservatory of music and the first medical school on the West Coast. The Santa Clara medical school was later acquired by Stanford University.

The College of Physicians and Surgeons in SF was secured in 1962. It is currently known as the Arthur A. Dugoni School of Dentistry.

UOP has extensive collections pertaining to jazz musician and alumnus Dave Brubeck. It is also home to the papers of environmental pioneer John Muir.

Due to its aesthetic likeness to East Coast Ivy League universities, the Stockton campus was featured in Hollywood films. Features include a tower, rose garden, architectural columns, brick-faced buildings, and numerous trees.
